Levesque, Desjardins, and Marquis Families



INTRODUCTION

The goal for this research session was to research the Levesque, Desjardins, and Marquis ancestral lines of the client as far as time and records allow.



FRENCH-CANADIAN RECORDS

For this project research consisted of French-Canadian genealogical records. One of the foremost commonly utilized sources for genealogy research in Québec are parish registers. Most parish registers have been preserved from 1621 to the present.

Civil registration was not begun until 1994 and is not a federal jurisdiction. These records vary depending on the municipality or parish and one may experience records that never existed, have been destroyed, or may have disappeared before they were digitized. For records after 1900, only the person named in the record or that person's legal representative can gain access to them.

There are some difficulties with French-Canadian research. It is possible that the parish or town had a name and/or designation change. For some municipalities, the classification method within the register may have varied. Thus, the records may be in disorder, for 1786-1788, etc. Also, if there is no exact date for an event, research must be done page by page seeking the individual. The records are in French and sometimes the act is difficult to read because of the handwriting or the image is unreadable due to the poor image quality. Finding the actual name of an ancestor is sometimes one of the most difficult things to do.

Maiden Names

In the United States, it was quite common for a woman to take on the name of her husband, making it difficult to know the wife's identity and familial origins. In Québec, however, a woman generally used her husband's name in social settings, but was always referred to by her maiden name in official documents. This helps when tracing an individual's maternal line.

Spelling Name Variations

Spellings of surnames were not standardized until very recently. With their silent letters, French surnames especially lend themselves to a wide variety of spellings. When French-Canadian families moved to English-speaking areas, they may have translated their names into English, or modified spelling such as Roy becoming King or Petrowski becoming Peterson.

Compound Names

Compound given names, such as Jean-Luc, Jean-Paul, or Anne-Sophie are not uncommon. These are not considered to be two separate given names. The second part of a compound name may be a given name normally used by the opposite sex. However, the gender of the compound is determined by the first component.

"Dit" Names

A "dit" name is basically a nickname or alias, which is typically added to a surname. The use of "dit" names started in France with the military. An individual could also use a "dit" name to differentiate themselves, or their family, from someone else with the same name. A person's name is built like this:

- Pierre Beaugrand dit Champagne
- *Pierre* is the given (first) name
- Beaugrand, is, in this case, the patronym or ancestral family name
- *Champagne* is, in this case, the "dit" name

"Dit" names can be legally used to replace the original patronym, so one can find the same person known under a nickname or secondary surname at any time, for no particular reason:

- Pierre Beaugrand
- Pierre Champagne
- Pierre Beaugrand dit Champagne
- Pierre Champagne dit Beaugrand

LEVESQUE SURNAME

The Levesque surname is French, from the Old French eveske 'bishop,' Latin episcopus, with the definite article l(e), an occupational name for a member of a bishop's household.² It is the most frequent of several alternative spellings in French Canada. Surname variations: Levis, Legendre, Lesesne, Levee, Revere, Lavertu, Frisque, Leveille.

Per U.S. censuses, the Levesque family was found in the United States and Canada between 1880 and 1920. Maine had the highest population of Levesque families in 1880.


BIRTH RECORDS

Leo Alfred Levesque was born 2 May 1914 in Grand'Mère, Champlain (currently Shawinigan, Mauricie), Québec.³ His parents were Desire Levesque and Mexillia Grenier.

Claire Yvette Virginia Desjardins was born 4 February 1918 in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire. Ashe was the daughter of Amos Eximer Marquis and Ophelia M. Ouellette.

CENSUS RECORDS

Census records are easily acquired, and are the backbone of genealogical research, as they provide information regarding race, gender, age, year and place of birth, parents' places of birth, occupation, wages, parents' names, the identity of children, neighbors, and even addresses. For this reason, they are often the first records searched when starting research. However, census records also have potential flaws; for example, errors sometimes occurred when the enumerator miscopied information to the final form, or if the individual responding to the enumerator was difficult to understand. Other potential snags could happen if the enumerator neglected to ask certain questions or made assumptions, or if the person who provided the information was a child or a neighbor with only partial knowledge of the family. Finally, sometimes the respondent intentionally provided false information or neglected to provide complete and accurate data.


By comparing data from multiple census enumerations across an ancestor's life, we can gain insight into where he was born and when, where he believed his parents were born, and who his children were. In addition, elderly family members are often found living with their younger relatives in later censuses, and occupational information can be valuable in distinguishing between men with the same name in the same area. It is important to understand that the census information was provided to the enumerator by whoever was home—the head of the household, a child, and sometimes even a neighbor. For this reason, it is not uncommon to find minor

discrepancies in birth years and locations, and the data gathered from census enumerations must be taken into consideration with other evidence.

CENSUS RECORDS – LEO ALFRED LEVESQUE


In 1930, Leo (age 15) was living with his father, Desire (age 51) and sisters, Jeanette (age 21) and Loretta (age 19), in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire.⁵ His father's marital condition was "wd" for widower. Leo, his father, Desire, and his grandparents' places of birth were Canada-French. French was the language spoken in the home before coming to the United States. Leo's sisters were born in New Hampshire. The home they lived in was rented. Leo's father's occupation was "finishing." He worked at a refrigeration plant.

Leo Levesque (age 25) was living with his sister, Laurette, (age 29) in Nashua in 1940.⁶ The census was taken 5 April 1940. Leo married Claire Yvette Virginia Desjardins, the next month.

CENSUS RECORDS - CLAIRE YVETTE VIRGINIA DESJARDINS

In 1920, Claire (age 1 11/12) was enumerated with her parents, Emile (age 31) and Aurora (age 31) Desjardins and brothers, Harvey (age 3 3/12) and Albert (age 1/12) in Nashua, Hillsborough,

New Hampshire.⁷ Her parents were born in Canada (mother tongue French) and Claire and her brothers were born in New Hampshire.

Claire was enumerated in the 1930 census in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire with her parents, Emile and Aurore Desjardin, and brothers, Harvey, Albert, and Jean.⁸



Claire and her family were still living in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire in 1940.⁹ Claire's father, Emile, was listed as a "WD," widower. The family consisted of Claire's father, Emile, and brothers, Hervé [Harvey], Albert, and Jean. Also listed was a housekeeper, Loralee Armanda.

MARRIAGE RECORDS

Leo Alfred Levesque, (age 25) of Nashua, mill worker, married Claire Yvette Virginia Desjardins, (age 22) also of Nashua, office clerk, on 18 May 1940 in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire. ¹⁰ They were married by L. J. A. Doucet, Catholic Priest. This was the first marriage for Leo and Claire.

Leo's parents were recorded as Desire Levesque (age 52), resident of Nashua and a mill worker; and Mexilla Grenier (age 37), deceased, also of Nashua. Both Desire and Mexilla were born in Canada. Claire's parents were Emile Desjardins (age 52), deceased, of Nashua and an asbestos

WORLD WAR II DRAFT REGISTRATION

According to Leo's World War II draft registration card, he resided at 92A Lock Street in Nashua. 11 This was the same address on his father's naturalization card. He listed his birthplace as Grand'mere [Grand'Mère]; however, his birth record was never found. The date on the card corroborated his birth date of 2 May 1914 and the name of his wife, Mrs. Cleare [Claire] Levesque. Leo's employer was Gate City Cleansing Company. Also included was a physical description of Leo: 5'8" and weighed 130 lbs. He had blue eyes, blonde hair, and a light complexion.

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DEATH & CEMETERY RECORDS

A lot of death information can be found on *Find A Grave*. *Find A Grave* is a volunteer-run site and the information found there is only as good as the knowledge of the individual who added it. Additional verification should always be sought, but it is an excellent source for clues.

Leo died 22 February 1994 in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire. ¹² His death date was recorded on his headstone and in his wife's obituary. He was buried in the Saint Louis De Gonzague Cemetery in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire. The headstone has his name etched as Leo J. Levesque, not "A." His wife, Claire Yvette Virginia Desjardins, was also buried there. ¹³ She died 19 July 2005 in Nashua, Hillsborough, New Hampshire. ¹⁴




Per U.S. censuses, the Marquis family was found in the United States and Canada between 1880 and 1920. Ohio had the highest population of Marquis families in 1880.

BIRTH RECORDS

Loretta Marquis was born 29 August 1912 in Bradley, Penobscot, Maine. ¹⁸ She was the daughter of Amos Marquis and Ophelia M. Ouellette. This was verified through Loretta's sister, Alphenia Markee's [Marquis] birth record. ¹⁹ The record gave their parents' names and birthplaces. Amos Markee [Marquis] was born in Canada, and their mother Ophelia's surname was entered as Willett [Ouellette]. She was born in Fall River, Massachusetts.

CENSUS RECORDS – LORETTA MARQUIS

Loretta Marquis was enumerated in Old Town, Penobscot, Maine with her parents, Amos (age 49) and Ophelia (43), and siblings, Alphenia (age 19), Mildred (age 17), Ralph (age 13), Harold (age 10), Blanche (age 5), Eugene (age 2 1/12), and Clement (5/12).²⁰ Amos, a homeowner, came to the United States in 1886 from Canada [Québec] and was naturalized in 1893. Ophelia and all the children were born in Maine.



In 1930, the Amos Marquis family was still living in Old Town, Penobscot, Maine in the same house as in 1920.²¹ The family consisted of Amos (age 58); Amos' wife was now entered as Mary (age 52) and her birthplace is Massachusetts, not Maine. The children include Wilfred (age 28), Ralph (age 13), Loretta (age 18), Blanch (age 15), Eugene (age 12), and Clement (age 10).

WILFRED A. MARQUIS

The death of Wilfred Alphonse Marquis took-place at his home in Passadumkeag on Friday last, after a long illness at the age of 34 years.

Born in Bradley, he was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. Amos E. Marquisof that town, where he spent his youth removing with the family to this city 20 years ago. Beginning work in the grocery and market of his father here, remaining till the latter went out of business. 

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



Mexilia Levesque died 9 December 1919 in Sainte-Flore, Grand'Mère, Champlain (currently Shawinigan, Mauricie), Québec, Canada. While the date of death for Mexilia was not proven, she died before 1920 and according to the marriage of Desire and Mexilia's daughter, Lorette Levesque, at the time of Mexilia's death, she resided in Canada, not Nashua like Lorette's father, Desire. There was some conflicting information, as the ages at death for Lorette's parents did not match their birth years. The informant may not have known when Desire and Mexilia were born and may have guessed their ages at death.

Desjardins Family Origin Map, 1880






Morissette Family Origin Map, 1880






Ouellette Family Origin Map, 1880






Grenier Family Origin Map, 1880
